CLASS TITLE: GROUNDSKEEPER

BASIC FUNCTION:

Under supervision performs entry-level maintenance at a number of County facilities.

REPRESENTATIVE DUTIES: *(Performance of these functions is the reason the job exists. Assigned job tasks/duties are not limited to the representative duties).*

1. Installs parking bumper as needed.
2. Operates assigned power equipment to prepare and maintain dirt and grass areas; picks up refuse, cuts weeds, sweeps streets and gutters; maintains assigned equipment in operating order.
3. Locates cemetery plots from master plan; levels cemetery plots and head stones; digs graves and/or assists in grave digging.
4. Assists Maintenance Man as required.
5. Installs and maintains sprinkler systems.
6. Move furniture, equipment, and other items and materials as assigned.

EDUCATION AND EXPERIENCE:

Any combination of training, education, and experience that would provide the required knowledge and abilities. A typical way to gain the required knowledge and ability is: graduation from high school or successful completion of G.E.D. or high school proficiency exam or work experience related to the duties and responsibilities of the class.

LICENSES:

Valid Nevada Driver's license to operate equipment.
