CLASS TITLE: ROAD MAINTENANCE WORKER I

BASIC FUNCTION:

Under direction performs labor tasks in the construction and maintenance of streets, ditches and pond, parking lots, waterways, storm drains, alleys – and related public works facilities.

REPRESENTATIVE DUTIES: *(Performance of these functions is the reason the job exists. Assigned job tasks/duties are not limited to the representative duties).*

1. Performs functions including but not limited to moving, digging, weeding, chipping and patching.
2. Repairs and patches by hand-sweeping surfaces, loading and unloading gravel, chips, asphalt; raking and shoveling same, and operating chip patcher.
3. Participate in concrete work such as curb, gutter and sidewalk repairs.
4. Perform regular storm drain maintenance and emergency storm work.
5. Removes weeds and old vegetation from around places such as ditches, ponds, buildings, fences and sidewalks.
6. Clean and care for tools and equipment.
7. Performs other related duties as required.
8. Drives a variety of light duty trucks.

KNOWLEDGE, SKILLS AND ABILITIES:

One year of experience in heavy manual construction or maintenance work; Knowledge of street construction materials, tools and equipment; Knowledge of methods employed in basic laboring and maintenance work; Knowledge of safety precautions used in hazardous construction work; Ability to understand and carry out oral and written instructions; Ability to perform semi-skilled tasks in the construction of maintenance of streets, sidewalks, gutters and related public works facilities; Ability to work well with others.

EDUCATION AND EXPERIENCE:

Any combination of training, education, and experience that would provide the required knowledge and abilities. A typical way to gain the required knowledge and ability is: Any combination of training, education and experience that would provide the required knowledge and abilities related to performing tasks related to maintenance and construction of road and drainage.
