

1 **NYE COUNTY RESOLUTION NO. 2018-01**

2 **A RESOLUTION AMENDING NYE COUNTY RESOLUTION NO. 2014-25 SETTING SCHEDULE**
3 **OF FEES FOR NYE COUNTY EMERGENCY RESPONSE SERVICES**

4 WHEREAS, the Nye County Board of County Commissioners, at a regular meeting in 1985,
5 promulgated a schedule of fees for ambulance services; and

6 WHEREAS, the Nye County Board of County Commissioners approved, at its April 3, 1990
7 regular meeting, a revised schedule of fees for ambulance services; and

8 WHEREAS, the Nye County Board of County Commissioners approved, at its February 19,
9 2008 regular meeting, a revised schedule of fees for ambulance services; and

10 WHEREAS, the Nye County Board of County Commissioners approved, at its December 16,
11 2014 regular meeting, a revised schedule of fees for ambulance services; and

12 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Nye County Board of County Commissioners
13 as follows:

14 1. That the schedule of fees is hereby amended and shall be collected according to the
15 schedule of fees as shown in the attached Exhibit "A", which is incorporated herein by this reference
16 and shall supersede and repeal any conflicting policies, procedures, rules or regulations previously
17 promulgated.

18 2. That Resolution 2018-01 shall be published at least one time in a newspaper of general
19 circulation in Nye County prior to the fees and penalties going into effect.

6 **Fire/Hazmat/EMS Pay Schedule**

7 **Course Coordinator** – Paid @ \$20/hr. Responsible for planning and scheduling entire course,
8 including hotel room reservations, conference/meeting room reservations, and interactions with State.
9 Required to be present 100% of the time at the course.

10 **Lead Instructor** – Paid @ \$18/hr. Responsible for planning and prepping the course module(s). Must
11 be a certified instructor.

12 **Assistant instructor** – Paid @ \$15/hr for actual instruction time. Must be a certified instructor.

13 **Assistant** – Paid @ \$8/hr for actual time in class assisting instructor(s). Does not have to be a certified
14 instructor.

15 **Equipment and/or Vehicle Delivery and/or Pick-Up** – Paid @ \$8/hr.

16 **Equipment and/or Facility Maintenance** - Paid @ \$15/hr.

17 **Travel/Per Diem** – Standard GSA rates will apply. Travel status begins when the volunteer leaves the
18 station and ends when the volunteer returns to the station.

19 **Hotel** – Subject to approval by Director of Emergency Management. Must be approved at least 2 weeks
20 prior to start of course. * Exceptions may apply.

21 **Mileage** – A County vehicle will be utilized when available. If not, personal vehicles may be used and
22 reimbursed at current GSA rates. Attendees are expected to carpool whenever possible.

23 **CPR Course** – Fee of \$60/person & includes CPR card; \$30/person if a
24 County employee & includes CPR card; free for current/active volunteers & includes CPR card.
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
