

## NYE COUNTY VETERAN'S BANNER PROGRAM

### APPLICATION

The Nye County Veterans Banner Program was created for the County area to honor its past and present veterans for their service to our country and in turn, encourage a new generation to provide service to their country. The banner acts as a symbol of our gratitude that pays tribute to the commitment and courage displayed by individuals that have served in the Armed Forces.

#### **CRITERIA**

To qualify for the Veterans Banner Program, the following criteria must be met:

- The honoree is a present or past member of the United States Armed Forces.
- The honoree is a current, former resident or deceased resident within Nye County.
- The honoree's discharge from military service was not dishonorable.
- The applicant must be the honoree or the closest living relative to the honoree.
- The right of use of the honoree's name, military service information and photograph submitted with the application must not have been assigned or transferred to another.

#### **PROCEDURE**

1. Submit completed nomination form along with a photograph of the honoree in military uniform. The photo should be 5 x7 or larger. Digital photographs with a resolution of 300 dpi or higher will also be accepted.
2. A copy of the honoree's DD-214 (or applicable discharge information) or if still on Active Duty, a copy of the honoree's Military ID Card. This documentation will be attached to the release form once the nomination is accepted.
3. Nominations will be accepted from October –December every third year. The application deadline will be December 31<sup>st</sup> at 12:00 pm. On its first year, the application period will be from the date the Board of County Commissioners formally adopt the Program through Tuesday, April 17, 2018 at 5:00 p.m.
4. All applications will be assigned a number and use by the County will be based on a random drawing.
5. Banners will be raised for a minimum period of three years. The banner may then be replaced by another nomination using the same random drawing procedure as the initial selections.

**Submission of this application does not guarantee any use by the County. Nye County reserves the right to choose which nominees are subject to entry into the Program.**
