TITLE: A BILL PROPOSING TO AMEND NYE COUNTY CODE TITLE 15 BUILDING AND CONSTRUCTION, CHAPTER 15.32 PAHRUMP REGIONAL PLANNING DISTRICT IMPACT FEES, PERTAINING TO THE IMPACT FEE DEFERRAL OPTION AND THE EARLY PAYMENT INCENTIVE; AND PROVIDING FOR THE SEVERABILITY, CONSTITUTIONALITY AND EFFECTIVE DATE THEREOF; AND OTHER MATTERS PROPERLY RELATING THERETO.

WHEREAS, pursuant to NRS 244.119, the Nye County Board of Commissioners (Board) is authorized to amend the Nye County Code; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to NRS 278.020, for the purpose of promoting the health, safety and the general welfare of the residents of Nye County, the Board is authorized and empowered to regulate and restrict the improvement of land and to control the location and soundness of structures; and

WHEREAS, any such regulation, restriction and control must take into account the potential impairment of natural resources and the total population which the available natural resources will support without unreasonable impairment; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to NRS 278B.230, the Board may, by ordinance, determine that impact fees are to be collected at the same time as the fee for issuance of a building permit for the service unit; and

WHEREAS, the Board finds these changes to be appropriate and an improvement to the regulations;

NOW, THEREFORE, the Board of County Commissioners of the County of Nye, State of Nevada, does ordain (NRS 244.110):

NYE COUNTY CODE TITLE 17 IS HEREBY AMENDED AS FOLLOWS, with **Deletions** shown in strike-through red font, and **additions and modifications** shown in underscored blue font:

15.32.080: TIME OF PAYMENT:

The impact fee shall be determined and ~~may shall~~ be paid at a discounted rate at the same time as the fee for issuance of a building permit, or the impact fee may be deferred as further described below. The applicant for a building permit shall pay the impact fee.

A. Impact Fee Deferral Option: An applicant may elect to defer the impact fee payment until after construction is completed, and prior to issuance of the certificate of occupancy. Should an applicant choose to defer the payment of the impact fee until after completion of construction, the applicant shall pay the full amount of the impact fee prior to occupancy of the building. A certificate of occupancy shall not be granted until the impact fee has been paid.

B. Early Payment Incentive: If an applicant elects to pay the impact fee at the same time as the fee is paid for the issuance of a building permit, the total amount of the impact fee due shall be reduced by ten percent (10%) as an early payment incentive. (Ord. 455, 2014)

If any provision of this ordinance or amendments thereto, or the application to any person, thing or circumstance is held to be invalid, such invalidity shall not affect the validity or provisions or applications of the ordinance or amendments thereto which can be given effect without the invalid provisions or applications, and to this end the provisions of this ordinance and amendments thereto are declared to be severable.

CONSTITUTIONALITY. If any section, clause or phrase of this ordinance shall be declared unconstitutional by a court of competent jurisdiction, the remaining provisions of this ordinance shall continue in full force and effect.
