## ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER 2020-4

On April 20, 2020, the Pahrump Justice Court issued an order temporarily closing the Court due to court personnel's possible exposure to a person who tested positive for Covid-19. The issue is now resolved and the Pahrump Justice Court will re-open for business on May 4, 2020 at 8:00 a.m., pursuant to the previous Covid-19 Administrative Order issued on March 24, 2020. However, Governor Steve Sisolak issued a new directive on April 29, 2020 and a press conference on April 30, 2020, in which he outlined steps for a phased re-opening of Nevada's economy and systematic lifting of Covid-19 restrictions. In light of the Governor's new directives, the Pahrump Justice Court hereby issues the following changes to its previous Covid-19 Administrative Orders, effective May 4, 2020:

1. The Court will still conduct all hearings by telephonic or video appearance only until at least May 15, 2020, and will re-evaluate any changes to in-person appearances at that time.
2. A limited number of customer service windows will be open to assist the public in person, as well as by telephone and email, or submission of documents via drop box in the Pahrump Justice Court lobby.

1           3. Any individuals appearing in person at the Pahrump Justice Court will be  
2           required to wear masks and gloves effective May 4, 2020.  
3           4. Any persons showing symptoms of Covid-19, as defined by the CDC, are  
4           prohibited from entering the Pahrump Justice Court and shall contact the court  
5           via phone or email to reschedule their hearing, or to obtain assistance on any  
6           other matters.


7           The following hearings will be conducted with all attorneys and parties appearing  
8           by video or telephone only, beginning May 4, 2020:


9           1. Criminal hearings: Initial appearances, arraignments, bail hearings, pretrial  
10           hearings, and status hearings.  
11           2. Civil hearings: protective order hearings, and emergency hearings regarding a  
12           landlord's willful interruption of essential utility's necessary for tenant's survival.

13           All other provisions set forth in the Court's previous Covid-19 Administrative Order,  
14           issued March 24, 2020 shall remain in effect until further notice. This Administrative  
15           Order is posted on the Nye County website and copies may be obtained by emailing the  
16           Court at [pjc@pahrumpjusticecourt.com](mailto:pjc@pahrumpjusticecourt.com), or by contacting the court at (775) 751-7050.

17           This order will be re-evaluated on or about May 15, 2020 for any necessary  
18           changes as Governor Sisolak issues new directives.
