

1 **NYE COUNTY RESOLUTION NO. 2020-14**

2 **A RESOLUTION TO CREATE A FUND ENTITLED NYE COUNTY TONOPAH MUSEUM FUND**

3 WHEREAS, the Nye County Board of County Commissioners, upon its full consideration of the
4 issues, has concluded that there is a need to maintain the revenues and related expenditures for the
5 Tonopah Museum in a separate fund and,

6 WHEREAS, pursuant to NRS 244.377, the Nye County Board of Commissioners has the authority
7 to pay to a nonprofit historical society the proceeds of a tax levy, for the purpose of conducting activities
8 related to a County museum,

9 WHEREAS, the Nye County Board of Commissioners has levied a tax to cover expenses related
10 to the Tonopah Museum

11 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that a special revenue fund entitled TONOPAH
12 MUSEUM FUND (Fund # 10215) shall be created under the following conditions:

- 13 1. The fund shall be used to account for all revenues and expenditures for the Tonopah Museum;
14 and
- 15 2. The tax proceeds paid into the Tonopah Museum Fund shall be used to pay salaries for museum
16 personnel, build and maintain exhibits, purchase cabinets, display items, conduct activities
17 related to the museum, and/or make capital improvements; provided, however, that not tax
18 proceeds may be used for capital improvements without the express approval of the Nye
19 County Board of County Commissioners; and
- 20 3. The Nye County Treasurer shall include this fund in the Treasurer's Report and bank
21 reconciliation, and allocate to the fund monthly all interest earned and unrealized gains and
22 losses on investments and cash in bank; and
- 23 4. The fund shall be subject to an annual independent audit at the same time all County funds are
24 examined.
- 25 5. All interest earned by the fund shall be transferred into the Nye County General Fund, and

1 6. The fund shall be subject to an annual independent audit at the same time all County funds are
2 examined.
