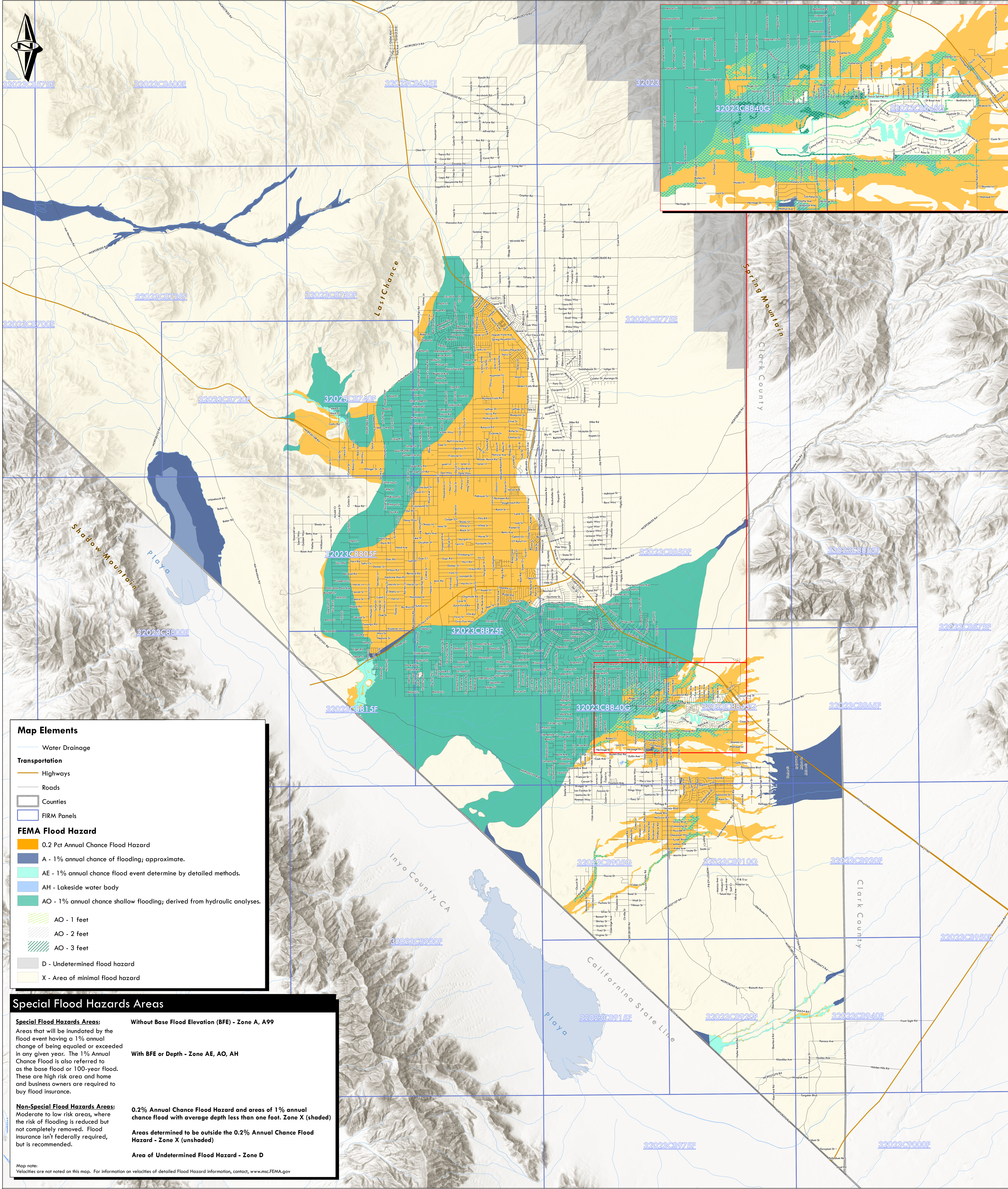

0.2 Pct Annual Chance Flood Hazard

A - 1% annual chance of flooding; approximate.

AE - 1% annual chance flood event determine by detailed methods.

AH - Lakeside water body

AO - 1% annual chance shallow flooding; derived from hydraulic analyses.

AO - 1 feet

AO - 2 feet

AO - 3 feet

D - Undetermined flood hazard

X - Area of minimal flood hazard

Special Flood Hazards Areas

Special Flood Hazards Areas:
Areas that will be inundated by the flood event having a 1% annual change of being equaled or exceeded in any given year. The 1% Annual Chance Flood is also referred to as the base flood or 100-year flood. These are high risk area and home and business owners are required to buy flood insurance.

Without Base Flood Elevation (BFE) - Zone A, A99

With BFE or Depth - Zone AE, AO, AH

Non-Special Flood Hazards Areas:
Moderate to low risk areas, where the risk of flooding is reduced but not completely removed. Flood insurance isn't federally required, but is recommended.

0.2% Annual Chance Flood Hazard and areas of 1% annual chance flood with average depth less than one foot. Zone X (shaded)

Areas determined to be outside the 0.2% Annual Chance Flood Hazard - Zone X (unshaded)

Area of Undetermined Flood Hazard - Zone D
