On March 21, 2023 the BoCC awarded Pahrump Valley Public Transportation \$60,700.00 to support the Rural and Youth Transportation Services Programs. The Youth Transportation Services have not gained any traction, so PVPT has expanded its current Beatty route to twice a week and now offers a Veteran's program that provides free rides to veterans not currently available within their existing programs.  This grant has been extended through June 30, 2026.

**1.) What did you accomplish during this reporting period and how did these accomplishments help you reach your stated project goal(s) and objective(s). Please note any significant project partners and their role in project activities.**

PVPT currently has consistent ridership for our Beatty transportation services. PVPT is providing transportation for Beatty residents every Tuesday and Thursday, (unless it falls on a scheduled holiday. Local veterans are utilizing our "free" non medical transportation on average providing nearly 100 trips per month

**2.) What, if any, challenges did you face during this reporting period and what actions did you take to address these challenges? Please note in your response; changes, if any, to your project goal(s), objective(s), or activities that were made as a result of challenges faced.**

One of the challenges faced by PVPT was in getting the residents of Beatty to schedule rides in a timely manner. PVPT requires one week notice for transportation services and on more than one occasion, Beatty residents were not conforming to our procedures. In an effort to overcome this obstacle, PVPT has made the Beatty route a permanent, twice weekly occurrence.

**3.) How have the activities conducted during this project period helped you to achieve the measurable outcomes identified in your project proposal?**

By adding the weekly Beatty trips, combined with the veterans transportation being provided PVPT feels that this funding is being utilized in the most productive manner. Although we have yet to receive any transportation requests from Amargosa, that option is still available.

Flyers have been passed out to various community businesses.

PVPT has witnessed increase in our local veteran transportation. Beatty residents are continuing the use of our services and PVPT has several newer passengers requesting rides.

PVPT has now met the requirements regarding the timely spending of available funding, ensuring that all available funds will be utilized as approved through Nye Co and the ARPA grant guidelines

PVPT services to Beatty and for our local veterans has greatly improved the quality of life for those who have opted to utilize our services

PVPT is constantly looking for ways to improve our service by looking into alternative funding sources such as: advertising on our vehicles, various other grants and contract revenues. This is in hopes of ensuring the future of these programs
