Nye County will be considering projects for the 2011-2012 **Nevada State Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) Program**. The public is invited to participate by providing ideas, comments and suggestions concerning proposed projects. The U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development has made approximately \$3 million available for grants for community facilities, planning and capacity building, economic development, micro-enterprise programs, and housing rehabilitation. These grants are available on a competitive basis to Nevada's 26 non-entitlement cities and counties. Nye County is eligible to apply for projects located in unincorporated areas of the county. Seventy percent of the projects funded must benefit communities and neighborhoods where at least 51% of the residents have annual household incomes of 80% or less of the median income for their respective counties.

Other items to be discussed at the meeting include:

1. Overview of the Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) program
2. Review of past performance and status of existing grants
3. Review of Housing and Community development needs statement
4. Review of preliminary grant application projects and selection process
